Hook: - Mustad 94840, Size 2-6
Thread: Black
Tip: Silver wire
Tail: Golden Pheasant crest
Ribbing: Oval silver
Body: Black wool
Wing: Native red squirrel
Cheeks: Jungle cock
Hackle: Yellow collar
Head: Black
